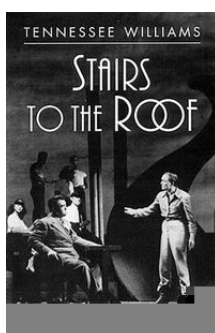


STAIRS TO THE ROOF
