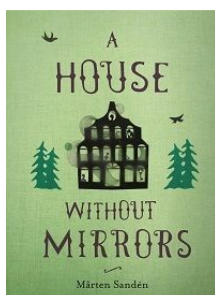


A HOUSE WITHOUT MIRRORS
