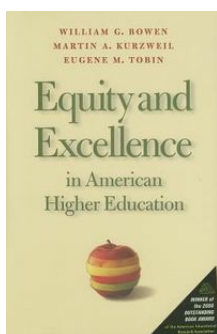


EQUITY AND EXCELLENCE IN AMERICAN HIGHER EDUCATION
