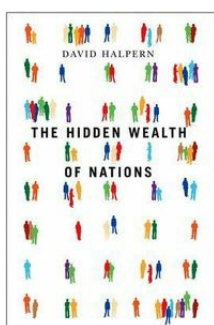


THE HIDDEN WEALTH OF NATIONS
