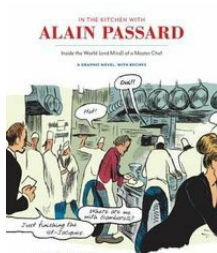


IN THE KITCHEN WITH ALAIN PASSARD
