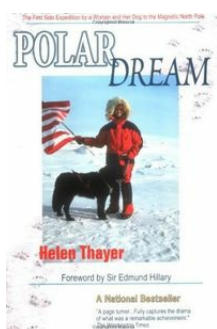


POLAR DREAM: THE FIRST SOLO EXPEDITION BY A WOMAN AND HER DOG TO THE MAGNETIC NORTH POLE

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
