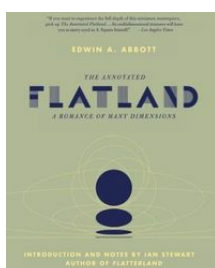


THE ANNOTATED FLATLAND: A ROMANCE OF MANY DIMENSIONS
