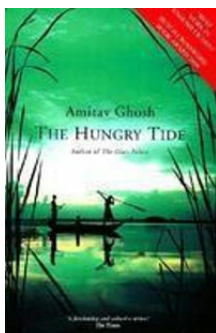


THE HUNGRY TIDE
