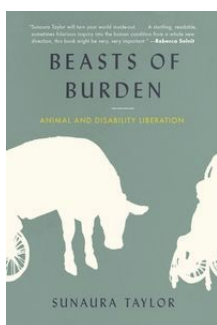


BEASTS OF BURDEN: ANIMAL AND DISABILITY LIBERATION
