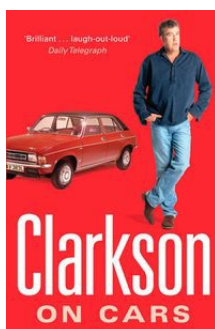


CLARKSON ON CARS
