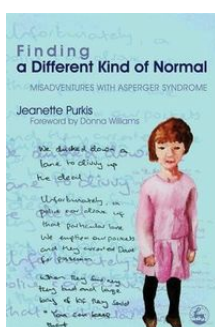


FINDING A DIFFERENT KIND OF NORMAL: MISADVENTURES WITH ASPERGER SYNDROME
