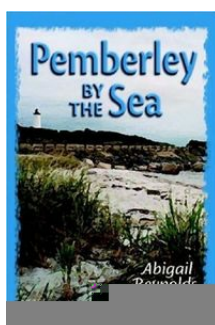


PEMBERLEY BY THE SEA
