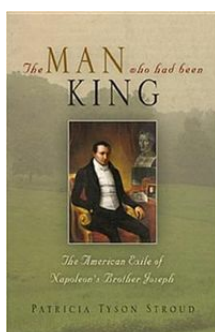


THE MAN WHO HAD BEEN KING: THE AMERICAN EXILE OF NAPOLEON'S BROTHER JOSEPH
