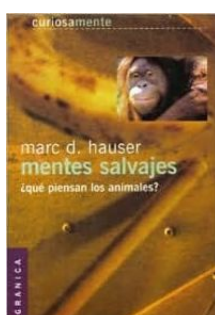


MENTES SALVAJES
